



Carriage Shoppe Expansion

327 Link Lane Fort Collins, Colorado

A 7,100 square foot addition to the existing Carriage Shoppe, an automobile body repair and paint shop increased the facilities size by sixty percent. This addition provided much needed staging area for parts and supplies for work in progress, the addition of a third paint booth and the relocation and addition of work stations to improve work flow. The secondary goal of the addition was to improve the street image of the dated 1960's preengineered building originally designed for retail sales. A split faced concrete block wall banded in two shades of gray was used to tie the old and new front elevations together in addition to reducing the amount of high storefront glazing. A seel trellis painted in the Carriage Shoppe's logo red accents the front and ends in a cantilever over the main entrance
